Super sleuth

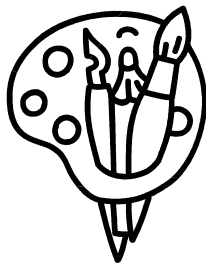
What are some of the traditional music, dances and performances that are important to your culture? What stories are told through these arts? How do they compare to the traditional Cambodia arts depicted in the film?

Creative corner

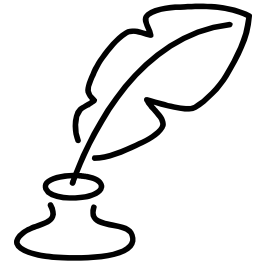
An apsara is a divine female spirit in Hindu and Buddhist mythology and apsara dancing has been an important part of ceremonies in the royal court since Angkorian times.
