It is a World Heritage Site, which means it has been recognised as having outstanding universal value to humanity. What facts can you find out about Angkor and the Khmer Empire?

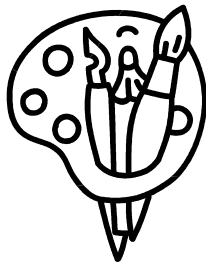

## Creative corner

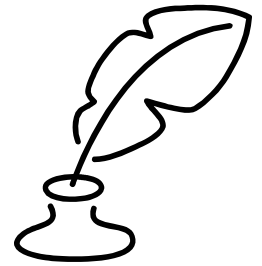
Consider how the Gecko kids have used different techniques, colours and styles to bring the bas-reliefs to life.
